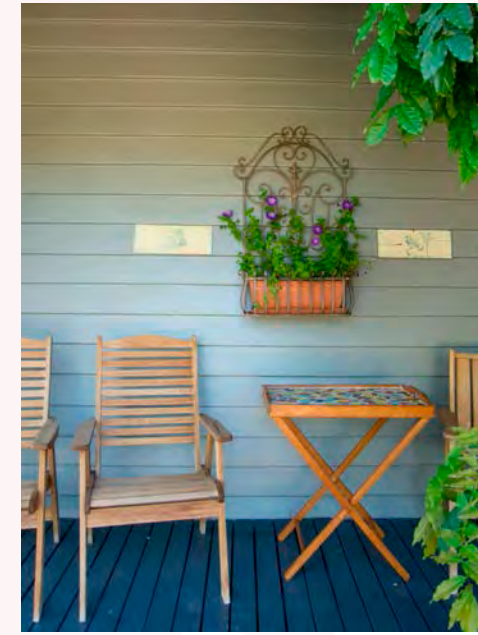


# FOURTH FINALIST



**Resene tips & tricks**

- + True grey can be too cool for many people's liking, so adding a smidge of another colour will change its character.
