It's wonderful to have festival-favourite filmmaker Jake Gorst (*Frey: Part I - The Architectural Envoy*, RADFF 2021; *Desert Utopia*, RADFF 2014) back on our screens with his new film *New England Modernism: Revolutionary Architecture in the 20th Century*. Other featured films include *Point of Origin* which documents the design and construction of one of Rem Koolhaas' smallest but most challenging commissions; *Green Over Gray* is a panorama of the visionary 'green architect' Emilio Ambasz and *Fashion Reimagined* charts a trailblazing fashion designer on a mission to create a sustainable collection from field to finished garment.

Each film explores stories that tell us about ourselves, revealing moments that have shaped our history and give glimpses as to where our innovations might lead us. From retrospections into modern history to explorations of progressive technologies, we're confident that the curation offers a comprehensive selection of films to entertain, educate, inspire, provoke thought and encourage critical thinking.

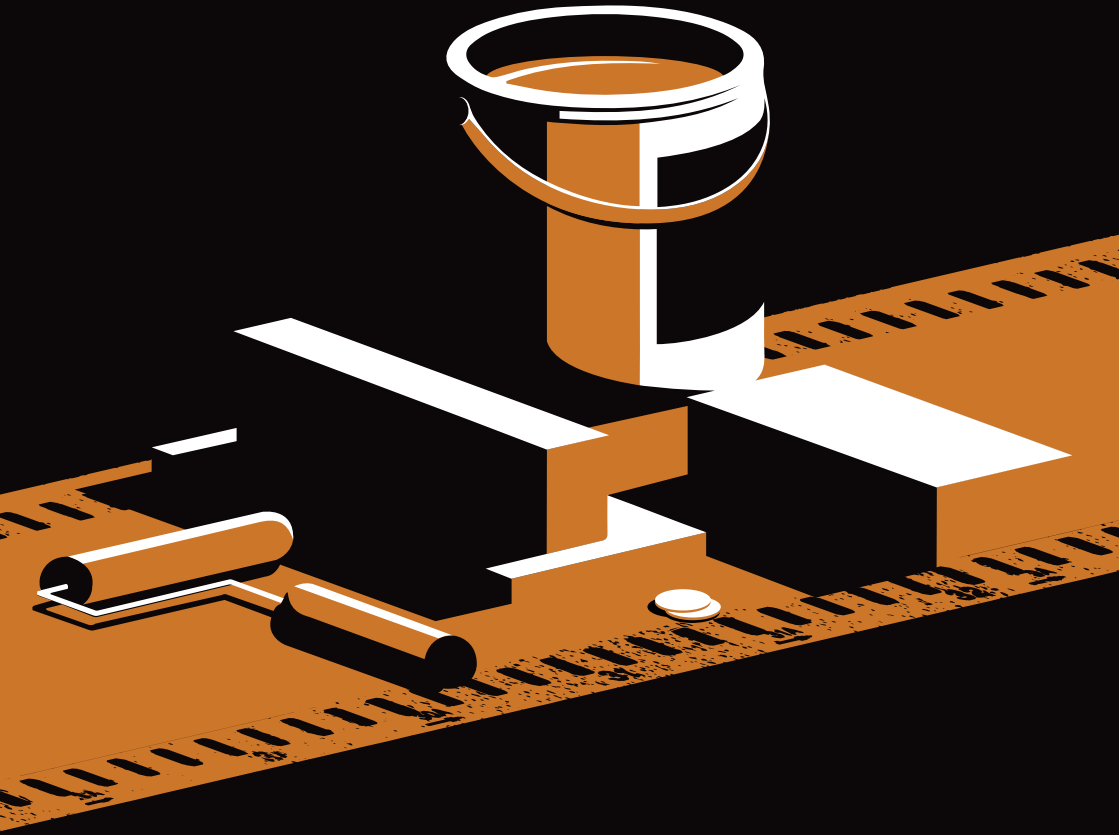
