Resene art with Mark Rayner – 16

Combine Resene crackle effect with Resene metallic paint to transform a plain Buddha statue into a real work of art.

### You will need:

- 25mm Resene paintbrush
- Ornamental Buddha statue (ours was an inexpensive garden statue made from heavy duty plastic)
- Resene Crackle Effect
- Resene Enamacryl Metallic tinted to Resene Isobar
- Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Black
- Resene Qristal Clear Poly-Gloss
- Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer
- Sandpaper
- Small wooden plinth or box
- Square of black velvet material
- Turpentine (for washing brush)



#### Step one

Lightly sand the statue to provide a 'key' and apply one coat of Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer using a 25mm paintbrush. Allow to dry.



#### Step two

Apply one coat of Resene Black to the statue and allow to dry.



#### Step three

Apply one coat of Resene Crackle Effect to the statue and allow to dry. Note: the thicker you apply the Crackle Effect, the larger the cracks will be.



#### Step four

Stir the Resene Enamacryl Metallic paint with a flat wooden stirrer – this ensures even distribution of the metallic particles throughout the paint.



### To get the look:

Mark painted the surrounding wall with Resene Zylone Sheen tinted to Resene Jive.



#### Step five

Starting at the head, apply one generous coat of Resene Enamacryl Isobar to the statue using the 25mm paintbrush.



#### Step six

Gradually work your way down the statue until the entire surface is covered with Resene Enamacryl. Leave to dry.



#### Step seven

Apply one coat of Resene Qristal Clear Poly-Gloss to the statue and allow to dry. Wash the brush out in turps.



#### Step eight

Position the wooden plinth or box and cover with black velvet material, then stand the Buddha in position.

### Other ideas:

Create a more textured look by applying a coat of Resene Sandtex mediterranean effect to the statue between steps one and two.
