You will need:

- Bamboo skewers cut to 40mm lengths (you might need a grown up to do this)
- Paintbrush
- Resene Art Action Quick Dry
- Resene testpots of Resene All Black, Resene Bowie and **Resene Root Beer**
- Self-hardening modelling



Mould the hedgehog body out of modelling clay and insert the bamboo or matchstick 'spines', as shown. Allow to dry overnight.



Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry to the hedgehog body and 'spines' and allow to dry.



Step three

Apply two coats of Resene Root Beer to the hedgehog body and 'spines', allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step four

Paint in the eyes and nose with Resene All Black and Resene Bowie. How fab is that?

Create this fabulous prickly hedgehog model with a little bit of help from Resene.



If you don't have any bamboo skewers craft matchsticks instead or even twigs from the garden.



Here's another idea:

goldfish cool was made from selfhardening modelling clay and painted with Resene Alabaster, Nero Resene Resene Sorbus.
