### You will need:

- Clean cloths
- Mineral turps
- Paintbrushes
- Paint stirrers
- Resene Interior Paintwork Cleaner
- Resene Paint Pot
- Resene Super Gloss enamel tinted to Resene Avocado
- Resene Wood Primer
- Sandpaper
- Wooden stool



**Step one**  
Thoroughly clean the stool with Resene Interior Paintwork Cleaner.



**Step 2**  
Lightly sand the legs of the stool.



**Step 3**  
Wipe off any sanding residue with a clean cloth.



**Step 4**  
Carefully stir the Resene Wood Primer.



**Step 5**  
Apply one coat of Resene Wood Primer to the legs and underside of the stool and allow to dry.



**Step 6**  
Carefully stir the Resene Super Gloss enamel tinted to Resene Avocado.



**Step 7**  
Apply one coat of Resene Super Gloss enamel tinted to Resene Avocado to the legs and underside of the stool and allow to dry. Apply a second coat if necessary and allow to dry.



**Step 8**  
Wash brushes in mineral turps.

It's easy to transform a plain wooden stool into a glossy retro feature using Resene Super Gloss enamel.



To get the look: Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Flat tinted to Resene Coconut Cream.



**Other ideas:**  
For a bright yellow effect paint the stool with Resene Fizz. You can use Resene Enamacryl if you prefer a waterborne finish.
